| Certified | An Instructor who has successfully completed a training clinic and evaluation within a context. A certified Instructor is able to instruct and certify students within the context. Eligible for 1st recertification at the end of the 3 year certification period then Certification moves to 5 year period | |
| Current | A certified Instructor who has registered with Sail Canada for the current year and who has prerequisites which have not expired. | |
| Instructor Clinic | A course at which instructors are trained and assessed within the desired context. Organized by Provincial Sailing Associations, includes both land and on-water sessions. | |
| Registering With Sail Canada | All Cruising Instructors are required to register with Sail Canada each year in order to able to award Sail Canada sailors levels and to obtain their personal liability insurance. Registration can be completed through your Sail Canada profile at www.sailing.ca | |
| Reporting Participation | Sail Canada uses an online participation and assessment tracking system powered by Checklick to track participation and student records. All instructors are required to use this system to report completed student certifications. | |
