OPEN AND OBSERVABLE INTERACTIONS

All interactions in sailing between athletes/participants and coaches, instructors, officials, staff or any other Person in Authority should be open and observable.

WHAT DOES AN OPEN AND OBSERVABLE INTERACTION LOOK LIKE?

- On Land:
 - In a public, open space, where others can see and take note of the interaction.
- On the Water:
 - Within a visible distance of other boats.

RULE OF TWO

Ideally, in potentially vulnerable situations, such as a closed inside space, two screened organization leaders should always be present with an Athlete, especially a Minor Athlete.

Keep the 'Rule of Two' best practices in mind to help maintain open and observable interactions between Athletes and Persons in Authority.
