These must be valid until August 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2025. Applicants who do not yet hold all these qualifications, but who plan to obtain them by the end of April 2025, are encouraged to apply.

Successful applicants over 18 will be required to submit a vulnerable sector (level 3) police record check.
