POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

- Supervising children from ages 7-16.
- Teaches CANSail curriculum as prescribed by the Senior Staff and Sail Canada.
- Responsible for ensuring that their division's schedule and general course plan is being followed.
- Act as a role model for the following traits: leadership, moral integrity, friendliness, diplomacy, honesty, fair play, sportsmanship, and open-mindedness.
- Organizes on-land activities and games for varied weather conditions.
- Constantly uses discretion and good judgement in relationships with children and exhibits proper behaviour. Incumbents must be able to interact with many personalities in various age groups accordingly.
- Attend meetings, training activities, course and all other work-related activities as required.
- Performs related duties as assigned by their reporting Supervisor or Management.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS

- Excellent Communication and interpersonal skills as instructing children.
- Current CANSail ½ Instructor Certification or equivalent experience, with a minimum of one year experience instructing.
- Current First Aid & CPR (or equivalent) certification.
- Current Pleasure Craft Operator's Card and Boat Safety course.
- Toronto Port Authority Operators Permit (Toronto Harbour Licence.)
- Police Check and Vulnerable Sector Screening if 18+ (we can assist with this.)
- Must be enthusiastic, professional, proactive, and demonstrate a true passion for youth sailing.

GENERAL COMMENTS

- This is a seasonal position from end of June to end of August including a mandatory training week (June 23 to 27.)
- Work week is typically Monday to Friday (8am to 5pm but timing may change due to programming.)
