- Be enthusiastic, professional and demonstrate a true passion for keelboat sailing

- Submit a curriculum plan and lesson plans
- Be able to liaise effectively with the Boulevard Club Yachting Director
- Perform maintenance and cleanliness of keelboat fleet, coaching equipment, and instructional spaces
- Provide an inclusive, welcoming, and flexible learning environment for all participants
